Copper Range

South Australian-focused Copper Range has exploration tenements in the Stuart Shelf and Adelaide Fold Belt.

The Stuart Shelf contains the Olympic Dam deposit, one of the world's largest copper resources, and recent discoveries have confirmed it as the world's foremost iron oxide copper-gold province.

The company's discovery drill hole intersected nearly 180m of high grade Olympic Dam-type copper-gold and finished in mineralisation.

The Stuart Shelf region also has potential for the discovery of high grade uranium deposits, similar to those of Canada's Athabasca Basin.

The Adelaide Fold Belt, in the Flinders Ranges, has not seen significant copper exploration for some time but Copper Range has identified a number of targets in the area. Targets for gold and uranium have also been recognised.

The company aims to establish a sustainable copper exploration, development and mining company.
